The Willowsford Conservancy Board of Trustees is accepting applications from Willowsford homeowners who are interested in serving on the board.

We are looking for individuals who are passionate about promoting the Conservancy's mission and work to the Willowsford community. Trustees should be committed to helping establish closer linkages between residents, the Conservancy, and the unique open space and natural resources the Conservancy safeguards for resident use.

In accordance with Conservancy by-laws, the founder plans to appoint two homeowners for a one-year term beginning in January 2020.

Homeowners in good standing who are 18 years of age or older can submit a statement of interest to info@willowsfordconservancy.org by **August 16, 2019**, including

- Name, address, and length of time in the community
- Have you volunteered with Willowsford Conservancy before, and in what capacity?
- Where else have you volunteered? In what capacity and for how long?
- Why are you interested in joining the Conservancy Board?
- What are your top priorities to accomplish should you be selected?
- What areas of the Conservancy's Mission are you most passionate about?
- What is your long-term vision for Willowsford Conservancy and the community?
- What do you think this role entails?

Board members are expected to

- Prepare for and actively engage during the bi-monthly board meetings;
- Bring a passion for the Conservancy's work and act as a spokesperson and liaison to the Willowsford Community at large; and
- Provide expertise, vision and strategic direction to help accomplish the Conservancy's Mission.

Expertise in the areas of (a) Business Finance & Accounting; (b) Land Stewardship/Environmental Conservation; or (c) Business Management & Operations would be particularly helpful.

We are also looking for strong advocates who can help engage residents with the Conservancy's work and help identify additional ways in which Willowsford's natural open space can support residents' values of active, sustainable, healthy community life, outdoor adventure, connection with nature, and learning.
