Located in Aldie and Ashburn, VA, the Conservancy manages 2,200 acres of natural open space including over 35 miles of natural surface trails and a 300-acre farm.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Develop and implement maintenance schedules.

### **Requirements:**

- Knowledge of gas and diesel-powered vehicles and equipment such as trucks, zero-turn mowers, tractors, skid loaders, and ATVs, agricultural attachments, trailers, and small engine equipment. Experience with equipment operation.

- Carpentry, welding, and fabrication experience preferred.

- Ability to use computers and software such as MS Outlook, Word and Excel, and maintenance tracking software.
