Claudette summarized the executive director search process that began in October with the professional support of Good Insights, a recruiting firm based in D.C. Over the course of several months the search committee reviewed and interviewed several high-quality candidates from a strong pool of applicants.

The committee recommended to the whole board the appointment of Sophie Lambert as the next executive director of Willowsford Conservancy. Sophie will begin her employment May 15. Sophie brings twenty years of experience as an urban planner and program director for nonprofit organizations. Most recently, she served in a senior leadership role for the Urban Land Institute (ULI), a nonprofit organization focused on creating livable communities. Before joining ULI, Sophie directed the LEED for Neighborhood Development program at the U.S. Green Building Council, working with experts and staff to create a rating system for evaluating sustainable neighborhood projects.
