

Grant Family Campsite in The Grant Village

The Grant Family Campsite is a walk-in campground featuring seven family-size tent pads, each suitable for one large, $9' \times 16'$ tent or two $8' \times 8'$ or smaller tents. Many of the campsites include posts for hammock camping in addition to the tent pad.

The Grant Village's expansive fields and woodlands provide opportunities for hiking, nature exploration and wildlife watching. The 8-mile Grant Loop Trail passes through wetlands, forests, meadows and agricultural lands. This moderate to difficult trail is suitable for walking, trail running and mountain biking, and features low-water crossings, rustic bridges, scenic vistas, and abundant wildlife.

Camping Season

The Willowsford camping season extends from May 1 through October 31.

Amenities

- The family-friendly tent sites are easily accessible from the parking area for walk-in camping (and some residents from The Grant or nearby neighborhoods might even choose to hike-in or bike-in!). Each tent site can accommodate up to eight people.
- Each tent site features a tent pad, fire pit, lantern holder, picnic table and charcoal grill (campers must provide their own charcoal, lantern, and kindling wood/firestarter).
- Firewood is included in the rental fee, and available at the camp site. Outside firewood is prohibited.
- The primitive campground includes a porta-potty style restroom with handwashing sink as well as potable water and nearby parking. There are no electric, sewer or water hook-ups.
- An obstacle course and other games can be found along the campsite loop.

Rates & Reservations

Grant Family Campsite is open to both residents and nonresidents. Willowsford Conservancy offers a discounted rate for Willowsford residents. Non-profit organizations, sports teams, scouting organizations are encouraged to book and can get the resident rate if a leader or member is a resident.

Willowsford Resident Rate: \$30/night

Non-resident Rate: \$50/night

If available, the entire Grant Family Camparound can be booked at a discounted rate:

Willowsford Resident Rate: \$200/night

Non-resident Rate: \$250/night

Reservations must be made through our website. If you need any help with booking your stay, please contact us <u>info@willowsfordconservancy.org</u>.

Please note that all reservations must be made at least 2 business days in advance of your stay and requests to book within 2 business days of your stay may not be accommodated. (For example, if you want to stay over on Saturday night, you would need to make the booking no later than COB Thursday.) Our staff prepares the campground prior to each reservation and needs time to ensure it is ready for your stay.

Change of Date, Cancellations & Refunds

A booking date can be rescheduled at no cost to the renter if requested **at least five business days** in advance. In the case of inclement weather, renter may elect to postpone and reschedule their stay to another date if the renter provides at least **24 hours notice**. All rescheduled stays are based on availability of amenity space.

Cancellations and refunds are only granted if made with at least **five business days notice**, less a \$10 cancellation

Directions

Address: 23785 Everfield Drive, Aldie, VA 20105.

From Rt. 50, enter The Grant and continue north through the first traffic circle for about .9 miles. The gravel driveway and parking lot will be on the left. From Fleetwood Road, turn onto Everfield Drive and continue straight through three traffic circles, about 1.9 miles, until you see the gravel driveway and parking lot on the right-hand side.

General Rules

- A single camping stay may not exceed seven consecutive days.
- All motorized vehicles must be parked in the designated parking area.
- No ATVs or motorized scooters or bikes, trailers or RVs, and no generators are permitted at the campsites. No horses.
- No confetti is permitted.
- Firearms, fireworks or explosives of any kind are prohibited.
- Tent sites are limited to eight campers and one tent/canopy up to 9x16' or two tents/canopies up to 8x8'. More than eight people or two tents require an additional tent site.
- Campfires are permitted only within existing fire pits. Grills are for charcoal use only.
 Cutting of trees or tree branches and collecting of downed trees or tree limbs is prohibited.
- Campers are responsible for securing their food against wildlife; no food may be left out unattended at any time.
- Trash waste must be placed in the trash receptacles.
- Activities may not interfere with normal operation of the amenities or adjacent trails or walkways at any time.

Alcoholic Beverages

Alcoholic beverages are permitted at your tent site. Campers must be 21 years or older to consume alcoholic beverages. All campers must stay at their site with alcoholic beverages.

Parking

Parking is available for approximately 10 cars in the lot accessible from Everfield Drive. It is a very short walk to the campsites.

Displaying Rental Agreement

A copy of the rental confirmation email (which serves as the parking pass) **must** be displayed on the vehicle dashboard unless the Renter hiked or bikes to the site (in which case they should be kept by the Renter). Please show this to Willowsford Security if they visit the campsite during your stay.


